CONTINUING EDUCATION

CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: See Board Rule 121-4-.06 regarding Continuing Education requirements on the Board's web page at www.sos.ga.gov/plb/construct. To reinstate your license, you must have completed 4 hours of continuing education for each license year ending November 30, excluding the year in which you were originally licensed. Continuing education must be related to Plumbing and conducted by a college, technical college, or trade association. Retain documentation of continuing education for at least 5 years.

With your application, submit documentation of your having completed continuing education as follows:

- For license expired for less than one year: 8 hours
- Less than 2 years: 12 hours
- Less than 3 years: 16 hours

Note: If you also hold certification for Medical Gas, you must send in an updated photo ID card showing brazing and installation expiration dates for some time in the future.

Licenses expired for more than 3 years may be reinstated based on re-examination.

Issued August 1, 2011 by the Office of the Attorney General, Georgia
