

SYNOPSIS OF PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE
GEORGIA AUCTIONEERS COMMISSION RULES,
CHAPTER 55-1, "ORGANIZATION," RULE
55-1-.01, "ORGANIZATION OF COMMISSION"

Rule 55-1-.01 is repealed and a new rule of the same number is proposed for adoption.

Purpose: To update the language of the rule to reflect changes in Georgia law.

Main Features: Correcting the title of Joint Secretary to Division Director, and the name of the agency from State Examining Boards to Professional Licensing Boards.

55-1-.01 Organization of Commission.Amended.

(1)The Georgia Auctioneers Commission is hereby created under the Secretary of State and ~~Joint Secretary, State Examining Boards~~ Division Director, Professional Licensing Boards. The Commission shall be composed of six members, each of whom shall be appointed by the Governor, with the approval of the Secretary of State, and confirmed by the Senate. Five members of the Commission shall be licensed auctioneers who shall have been residents of this State and actively engaged in the auctioneering business for at least five years. One member shall be a resident of this State and shall have no connection whatsoever with the practice or profession of auctioneering.

(2) No person shall serve more than two consecutive years as chairman.
